# Mile Zero Regional Multiplex FIELD HOUSE GUIDELINES



- Patrons are allowed to bring their own equipment as long as they adhere to the facility guidelines.
- Children under 10 years of age must be <u>actively supervised</u> by a responsible person 14 years of age or older.
- Only non-marking indoor running shoes are permitted in the field house.
   Under no circumstances shall outdoor footwear (boots etc.) be worn on to the playing surface for sporting activities. Always change out of outer footwear before entering the Field House. Bare feet are not allowed.
- Food is absolutely forbidden in the Field House. Water is <u>ONLY</u> permitted.
- Please respect the Mile Zero Regional Multiplex equipment and structural components.
- Please return all borrowed sporting equipment to the Administration Office.
- Adhere to the rules associated with the various color lines on the courts for the activity that is scheduled.
- Only individuals participating in a scheduled activity in the field house are permitted on the playing surface. There is designated viewing areas for spectators.
- Move quickly when walking around or behind the courts. Distractions can cause an unfair advantage and can pose a safety risk.
- Keep your area clean while using the field house.
- Remain off the playing surface until your scheduled time of use.
- Sports groups and teams using the field house must be under the supervision of a coach or supervisor.
- Participants with open wounds are not permitted on the playing surface. Should an injury happen involving blood, please notify a Multiplex staff member immediately. All blood stains must be disinfected before play can resume.
- Strollers, walking aids, wheelchairs and other personal assistance devices must be free of dirt and debris before accessing the courts.
- The Town of Grimshaw is not responsible for lost or misplaced articles, theft or damage to personal belongings. Please deposit all personal belongings in a locker before using the field house. Found articles should be turned into the Fitness Centre for return to the rightful owner.
- Dogs are not permitted. Exception for service animals.

<u>Special Equipment:</u> Floor Hockey Equipment: Only sticks with a plastic blade will be permitted on the field house playing surface. No wooden or taped blades are allowed.

# Running/Walking Track Hours of Operation:



Walk, jog or run your way to a healthier you one step at a time. This (175.3 metre) three lane elevated indoor running/walking track is an ideal location for both young and old to enjoy and is wheel chair and stroller accessible. The Running/Walking Track is accessible by the public via the front staircase or elevator. (9 laps is one mile)

Before using the track all patrons must sign in at the Fitness Centre front counter. Periodic surveys will take place to help assist the Town of Grimshaw in a number of areas. This includes programming, maintenance of the track, hours of operation etc.

Weekdays: 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. - Trial Basis

Weekends: 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Stat Holidays: 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. (Closed on Christmas Eve, Christmas Day,

Boxing Day, New Year's Day and Easter Sunday)

All children 13 years and younger must be accompanied and supervised by an adult while using the running track.

Ask the Fitness Centre staff about the COMBO facility membership packages available for purchase.

# Mile Zero Regional Multiplex Facility Running/Walking Track Rules:



- Please consult a physician before using any of our recreational facilities.
- Spectators are not permitted on the track at any time.
- Travel in a counter clockwise direction only in a single file on this 175.3 metre three lane track. (9 laps is one mile)
- Do not stop on the track while walking, jogging or running. If you need to rest please move to the corner areas along the track.
- Slower traffic keep to the inside lane to allow runners and faster walkers to keep their pace.
- Larger crowds should space themselves.
- Children under 13 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- Caution must be used when entering and exiting the track.
- Always look before crossing lanes so you do not interfere with anyone in another lane.
- Do not race when the track is busy.
- Strollers, wheel chairs and walkers are welcome, please walk in a single file on the inside lane only.
- Only non-marking indoor running shoes are permitted on the track. Under no circumstances shall outdoor footwear (boots etc) be worn on to the track surface. Always change out of outer footwear before entering the track. Bare feet are not allowed.
- The Town of Grimshaw is not responsible for lost or misplaced articles, theft or damage to personal belongings. Found articles should be turned into the Fitness Centre for return to the rightful owner.
- Food is absolutely forbidden on the track surface. Water ONLY permitted on the track.
- Dogs are not permitted. Exception for service animals.

## Fitness Centre Use Policies & Procedures as follows:

- Facility is not available for reservation.
- You must have a current membership or day pass to gain admittance.
- Only non-marking indoor running shoes are permitted in the Fitness Centre. Under no circumstances shall outdoor footwear (boots etc.) be worn into the facility. Always change out of outer footwear before entering the Fitness Centre. Bare feet or open toed shoes are not allowed.
- Food is absolutely forbidden in the Fitness Centre. Water is ONLY permitted.
- Please respect the Mile Zero Regional Multiplex equipment and structural components.
- Replace your weights. Equipment is not to be left on the machines or on the floor. Please do not drop weights.
- Use a spotter when lifting free weights. Collars are mandatory on barbells.
- Report all injuries and equipment/facility irregularities to a staff person immediately.
- The staff reserves the right to refuse service to anyone who fails to comply with our facility rules and regulations. Any behavior deemed inappropriate may result in a loss of access privileges.
- Youth aged (12 to 14) years may use the facility cardio equipment under the supervision of a parent/guardian. Patrons 15 years and older have full access to the facility.
- The Town of Grimshaw is not responsible for any lost/stolen items. Day use lockers are available for check out. Please talk with the staff for more information.
- Patrons and staff are expected to follow all posted regulations.

### Fitness Centre Etiquette:

- Please put away all weights and other equipment when finished.
- Do not drop weights.
- Share the equipment. Allow others to "work in" when you are resting.
- Limit time on the cardio equipment to 20 minutes when others are waiting.
- Avoid using heavy cologne or perfume prior to working out in the fitness Centre.
- Respect others. This includes other patrons and Fitness Centre staff.

## LOCKER & SHOWER ROOMS

## Fitness Centre & Running/Walking Track Users:

While using the Fitness Centre and/or Running / Walking Track, all members and guests may use a locker located in the Fitness Centre, based on availability.

- Lockers are day use only and belongings may not be left overnight.
- All property must be removed from lockers immediately following workouts.
- Lockers are not for private use and the Town of Grimshaw reserves the rights to inspect all lockers, as well as to remove any lock left on the locker.
- Locks and contents not removed at the close of each day will confiscated. Belongings can be picked up at the Fitness Centre front counter.
- Glass containers are prohibited in the locker and shower rooms.

## Arena Use Policies & Procedures as follows:

In order to operate the Mile Zero Regional Multiplex (Arena) in a safe and efficient manner, expectations are that all users shall abide by the following rules and regulations:

- Smoking is only permitted in designated areas outside of the facility.
- Consumption of alcohol is not permitted, unless a Special Events Rental Agreement has been approved.
- Children under the age of 12 years of age are to be supervised at all times by a parent or a designated adult.
- A minimum of 2 coaches or designated adults should be in the dressing rooms with individuals under the age of 18.
- The Town of Grimshaw has the discretionary right to refuse to rent ice.
- Locks for dressing rooms can be signed out from the Arena staff at your own risk. People signing out locks assume responsibility for the return of the lock and the security of the dressing room.
- Users must abide by their scheduled practice/game times.
- No players are allowed on the ice surface without their coaches being present and without the proper equipment.
- Sticks and pucks are to be used on the ice surface only. Persons hitting sticks or pucks against walls etc. will have their equipment confiscated and will be required to clean the area or pay for damages.
- Dressing rooms are to be left in a neat and orderly manner and vacated within 30 minutes after rental time has ended. Any infraction of the rules will result in a minimum surcharge.
- All teams will be held responsible for their dressing rooms.
- No one is to be on the ice while the Zamboni is being operated, unless instructed by Arena personnel to assist. Wait until the Zamboni gates are closed before going onto the ice surface.
- Spectators found throwing debris onto the ice surface or using vulgar language will be immediately ejected from the facility.
- Please keep all fire exits, doors or any other marked areas clear.
- The Town of Grimshaw is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- Bicycles, skateboards, scooters, heelies and pets are not permitted within the facility.
