

TOWN OF GRIMSHAW

Bylaw No. 1190

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF GRIMSHAW IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING TOWN OF GRIMSHAW LAND USE BYLAW No. 1146.

WHEREAS Pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, Council may amend a Land Use Bylaw, and;

WHEREAS The Council of the Town of Grimshaw, in the Province of Alberta, has adopted the Town of Grimshaw Land Use Bylaw No. 1146, as amended, and;

WHEREAS The Council of the Town of Grimshaw, in the Province of Alberta, deems it necessary to amend the Town of Grimshaw Land Use Bylaw to revise provisions related to the legalization of cannabis. and;

NOW
THEREFORE Pursuant to Sections 230, 606 and 692 of the Province of Alberta Municipal Government Act, the Town of Grimshaw Council, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. Add the following definition for “Cannabis” to Section 4:

“CANNABIS” means cannabis plant, fresh cannabis, dried cannabis, cannabis oil and cannabis plant seeds and any other substance defined as cannabis in the Cannabis Act and its regulations, as amended from time to time.

2. Add the following definition for “Cannabis Retail Sales” to Section 4:

“CANNABIS RETAIL SALES” means a retail store licensed by the Alberta Liquor and Gaming Commission (AGLC) where cannabis and cannabis accessories are sold to individuals who attend at the premises.

3. Add the following definition for “Cannabis” to Section 4:

“CANNABIS PRODUCTION FACILITY” means a premise used for growing, producing, testing, destroying, storing, or distribution of cannabis authorized by a license issued by Health Canada.

4. Revise the following Section 62(3) Similar Uses to:

(a) A similar use to one of those listed under a land use district may be allowed at the discretion of the Development Officer and Municipal Planning Committee if, in their opinion, it is sufficiently similar in character and purpose to a listed use, but is not listed as a use in another district or defined in the Definitions section.

5. If any portion of this bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion shall be severed.
6. That this bylaw shall take force and effect on the date of its final passage.
