

Collection begins October 1st in Town of Grimsshaw

CURBSIDE RECYCLING

Effective October 1, 2015, the Town of Grimsshaw recycling program is changing. All residents will be given a blue recycling cart that "ALL" recyclables can be placed into.

What can go in the mixed recycling cart?

Newsprint/Heavy Paper: newspaper, magazines, phone books, catalogs, flyers

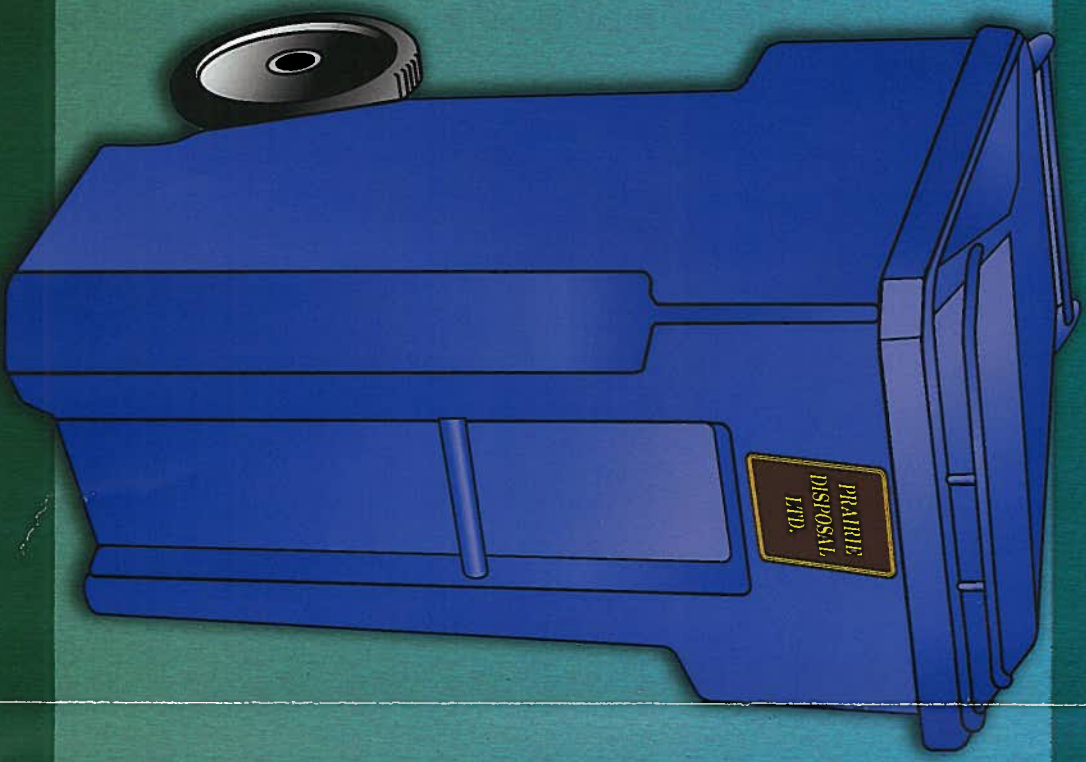
Mixed Paper: office paper, junk mail, shredded paper, etc.

Boxboard/Cardboard: cereal boxes, pasta containers, etc.

Containers: food cans, beverage containers, hard plastics # 1 - 7, deposit items

What day of the week is my mixed recyclables collected?

Recycle carts are to be placed at the curb every other Thursday for collection by 7:00 am. Please make sure they are placed 1 meter from any other objects. Refer to cart placement diagram.



What should not go into my blue mixed recyclables cart?

- ✗ Plastic toys
- ✗ Bubble wrap
- ✗ Styrofoam
- ✗ Glass of any kind
- ✗ Ceramics
- ✗ Toxic items (batteries, paint cans, aerosol cans)
- ✗ Electronics or small appliances
- ✗ Diapers
- ✗ Scrap metal or wood
- ✗ Food or yard waste
- ✗ Unrinsed or soiled food containers
- ✗ Soiled paper (used tissue or paper towel, pizza boxes smeared with cheese, etc.)
- ✗ Soiled containers
