Residents that are on a monthly payment plan will receive an attachment on their tax notice with a new monthly amount.

Residents are also reminded to carefully review their property tax notices. If you have any questions or concerns regarding the assessment, please contact our assessor, Grant Clark from KCL Consulting. Grant will speak with you directly to provide clarification and answer any inquiries. The Town of Grimshaw contracts KCL Consulting to conduct property valuations, land assessments, and ensure compliance with provincial regulations.
